



SCHOOL SUPPLIES

FOR FIRST GRADE

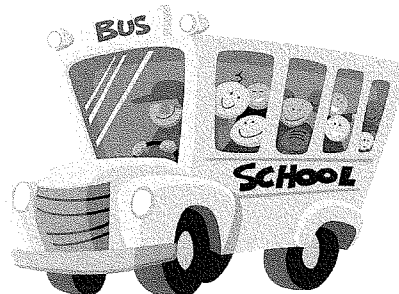
Your child should bring the following items with them to school on the first day:

- ✍ **Book Bag:** *Please make sure that your child's bag is big enough to carry a folder, winter clothes, lunch box, sneakers, etc. Label your child's bag with his/her name.*
- ✍ **1" Black or Blue Binder:** *Your child will need to bring in a 1" Binder. Please do not label the binder with your child's name.*
- ✍ **1 RED, 1 BLUE, and 1 GREEN Two-Pocket Folder:** *Your child will need 1 RED, 1 BLUE, and 1 GREEN two-pocket folder. Please get a plain folder with the pockets on the bottom NOT on the sides. Please DO NOT label your child's folders with his/her name OR any other information.*
- ✍ **Notebook:** *1 spiral bound one-subject notebook (please label with name)*
- ✍ **Composition Notebook:** *These are the notebooks that are marbled, with a very hard cardboard cover. They do not have a spiral binding.*
- ✍ **Pencil Box/Art Box:** *1 pencil box or small basket that will fit in their desk (please label with name). Please make sure pencils, crayons, scissors, and glue can fit in the container.*
- ✍ **Pencils:** *2 Dozen Yellow #2 Pencils (no mechanical or fancy). The students seem to go through these very fast. They will be put together for all to share, so please only send in the regular pencils.*
- ✍ **Crayons:** *Please only the 24 count crayons, at most.*
- ✍ **Markers:** *Please only the 8 count markers, the big fat ones. Please do not label these, as they will be put together for all to share.*
- ✍ **Glue:** *6 Glue sticks, 1 squeeze glue bottle.*
- ✍ **Scissors**
- ✍ **Baby Wipes:** *1 container of baby wipes. This helps to keep our room sanitary, and cuts back on the number of colds and absences due to sickness within the class.*
- ✍ **Kleenex:** *1 box of Kleenex*
- ✍ **Baggies:** *1 box of gallon zip lock bags & 1 box of sandwich size zip lock bags.*

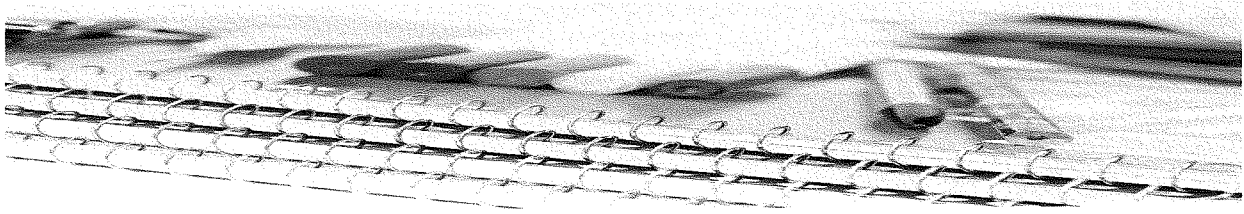
****Your child will also need sneakers for gym, and boots, a hat, gloves, and snow pants for winter.**

Listed below are some supplies I'm hoping you can pick up for your child for September. If you have problems finding things, let me know and I will help you. My email at home is pvdv@frontier.com. If you would like your child to send me an email over the summer I will answer them. It is a good way to get to know each other.

Please remember to put your child's name on clothes, book bags and lunchboxes. Make sure when you purchase a bookbag it should be big enough to hold winter clothes, sneakers, lunchboxes and folders. The cutesy little ones don't do it. Much to the contrary from what your child says they don't need to have wheels. Most of these supplies can be found in Walmart.

One one inch binder

One dozen pencils – we have a communal pencil cup.

Crayon – 24 count. No markers, I have a class set.

Glue sticks – three or four. I will periodically ask for more throughout the year.

A Plastic rectangular pencil box. It is about an inch thick and everything fits in there. (Please put your child's name on it.)

Zip lock bags: If your last name starts with A-M please send in gallon bags, N-Z quarts please

If you have any questions about this or anything else, please drop me a line at the above email address. Also, please remember to read with your kids and keep counting by 1's, 5's and 10's to 100. (We did do some work on the 2's also.)
