

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The N.Y.S. Education Law requires that all students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade and those planning on participating in a sport, have a physical examination completed and on file in the Health Office.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

Please take time to set up a physical exam with your family physician or your child's pediatrician. Having a physical examination done at their regular doctor ensures continuity of care and that all health records and immunization requirements have been met. Also, children feel more comfortable going to their own doctor.

This exam will fulfill the 7<sup>th</sup> grade AND sports physical requirement but must be on file in the High School Health Office by July 31, 2015 to participate in a fall sport. Please have your doctor fax the physical ASAP to Elementary School fax 661-6590/High School fax 661-7666 or have your child bring a copy to the health office.

Any physical done after June 19, 2015, please have the doctor fax it to 661-7666 Attn: Health Office.

Dr. Hanafi or Robin Adams, FNP, from Nathan Littauer's Mayfield Office, will conduct sports physicals. If you choose to have your child's examine done at school, please complete the following and return it to the Elementary School Health Office as soon as possible so that we have an idea of how many to expect.
